

FLOUNDER LIGHT

S.R.M. Multi-lite

The S.R.M. Sea Striker "Multilite" is a very useful and necessary item for the all-around sportsman, outdoorsman, or camping enthusiast. This light may be submerged under water safely for fishing at night for white bass, crappie, running trotlines, spearing flounder or other saltwater fish. It will provide safe, economical light for camping, picnics, or for emergency car repairs, as it is safe to use in any weather. It will last from 6-8 hours on a fully charged battery when using a 50-watt bulb and 12-volt D.C. source.

Care of Your Light

To get the maximum life from your light, rinse thoroughly in fresh water after immersing in salt water before storing. Keep oil or grease on the clamp to prevent deterioration. To change the bulbs, clamp the reflector web in a vice, firmly turning the globe counter-clockwise with a firm grip using both hands. In extremely cold weather, put light in a warm area, as this will allow the plastic to release from the globe easier. Apply a light oil or grease on threads of globe when reassembling, as plastic is abrasive.

1. Do not use over a 100-watt bulb as excessive heat will damage the plastic head.
2. Do not submerge the top end of the light handle.
3. When using you light underwater, always place the light in the water before connecting it to the battery. Placing a hot globe in the water may cause the bulb to blow out.
